## **CONCECRATION OF THE TOMBSTONE OF DUNERA BOY KURT KRISZHABER**

Kurt Kriszhaber was tragically killed in a gas accident in his home in Melbourne in 1946. At the time he had no family and was buried in an unmarked grave in the Fawkner Cemetery. David Nelson, a researcher at the Holocaust Museum and Education Centre in South Florida, came across Kurt's history and tragic death and decided to raise funds for a tombstone. This he has achieved thanks to many generous donors.

We wish to honour this Dunera Boy by holding a consecration service. The event will be videoed and recorded and placed on our Facebook page. It is further possible that with the help of the Dunera Project, we will be able to live-stream this event. It is fitting that this event will take place on the actual 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the arrival of the Dunera boys to Sydney
